Finishing Directions for Tart

Use these directions if you want to display your finished design in a Tart with a cloche and will need space between the finished piece and the rim of the Tart.

1. Using template, cut three circles from mat board, each $3\frac{3}{8}$ inches in diameter.
2. Layer 2 circles together. Add 5-6 layers of batting to top of one circle and then your stitched piece. Lace your stitched piece.
3. Lace finishing fabric only on the third circle.
4. Hand sew the two pieces together. Sewing gives you more control when joining pieces.
5. Sew ric rac trim to joined edge. (We used Lady Dot ric rac.)

Use these directions if you want your finished design to fill the Tart completely.

1. Using template, cut two circles from mat board, each approximately 4 inches in diameter.*
2. Add 2-4 layers of batting to top of one circle and then your stitched piece. Lace your stitched piece.
3. Lace finishing fabric or wool only on the second circle.
4. Hand sew the two pieces together. Sewing gives you more control when joining pieces.

*note: these directions and templates may need to be adjusted based on the size of the design you stitch and your HEARTWARE Tart. Each Tart is slightly different. For example, the circle sizing is approximate. It should fit inside the diameter of your Tart. If the circle is too large, just trim it until it fits inside the Tart.

Templates for Strawberry

1. Sew long sides of strawberry piece together.
2. Turn so seam is inside and sew a gathering stitch about $\frac{1}{4}$ inch from top.
3. Fill with cotton.
4. Pull top together. Tuck raw edge of fabric in and fasten thread securely.
5. Center and fasten green top with tiny blanket stitches.
